**General Information:**

Burlington County's 34<sup>th</sup> Annual **Arts in the Park** is a music, theater, dance and juried fine art & craft festival situated in Historic Smithville Park in Eastampton, NJ. Artists' work represents a broad spectrum of media and expression including painting, drawing, mixed media, photography, pottery and glass. Live entertainment is showcased on 4 stages. There are interactive art activities for children and their families to explore art materials and techniques. Eight to ten thousand people attend the event annually.

**Awards:** Awards will be given for excellence in medium in the following categories

Painting	\$100
Photography	\$100
Mixed Media	\$100
Drawing/Pastel	\$100
Fine Craft	\$100

**Fees:** \$50 for a 10'x10' space, due upon acceptance. Artists must supply their own tents (optional, but encouraged. Arts in the Park is a Rain or Shine event), tables, chairs, etc. Vendor fee is due within three weeks of receiving e-mail or letter of acceptance. If you fail to pay on time, you will be considered not interested, and dropped from the show. Checks will be deposited once received.

**Screening:** All applicants will be screened by the Arts in the Park Committee for participation. Primary factors considered for acceptance are variety and appeal of product, previous years' participation, and timeliness of application return. The screening process, best interest of the Arts in the Park event and date of application will be determinants of booth location. This application does NOT guarantee a space. All vendors will receive a notice of either acceptance or rejection.

## Important Dates to Remember:

**Application Deadline: June 1, 2010** or until full (applications are processed in order of receipt). Completed and signed application with digital images (either mailed on cd, or emailed to [llemyre@co.burlington.nj.us](mailto:llemyre@co.burlington.nj.us) . Incomplete applications will not be considered. Materials will not be returned.

**Space Fees Deadline: Upon acceptance.** Make \$50 check out "Treasurer, Burlington County". Vendor fee is due within three weeks of receiving e-mail or letter of acceptance. If you fail to pay on time, you will be considered not interested, and dropped from the show. Checks will be deposited once received. There are no refunds after checks are deposited.

**Set-up:** Sunday, September 26 from 8am to 10am only.

**Festival Hours:** Sunday, September 26, 11am to 5pm

**Tear-down:** Sunday, September 26 – 5pm\*

*\*Note: Organizations must not tear down before 5pm. Failure to comply jeopardizes participation in future events. Arts in the Park is a "rain or shine" event. Organizations should be prepared to continue in the case of light rain.*
